

2020 CROP & FORAGE SHOW PREMIUM LIST

- NOTICE:** a.) Baled hay samples not to exceed 8 inches thick.
b.) Any sample not meeting show requirements will be rejected.

The Crop and Forage Show is open to all persons. There are two divisions: **A - Open Class** and **B - Youth** (includes FFA & 4-H). An individual may show in only one division. Only one entry per lot. Individuals who farm together as a family unit may each enter one grain or forage exhibit per lot. All crops must be grown by exhibitor in 2019. Premiums will be paid in all lots as follows: **A.** 1-10 entries: 1st - \$8.00; 2nd - \$6.00; 3rd - \$4.00. **B.** 11 entries and over: 1st - \$10.00; 2nd - \$8.00; 3rd - \$6.00; 4th - \$4.00; 5th - \$2.00.

Entry Times: All FFA / 4-H / Open Class exhibits may be entered by 5:30 p.m. Tuesday, February 4th, or no later than 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, February 5th. All samples become property of the show and will not be returned.

All grain samples will be shown at the Minnesota State Fair.

GRAIN CROP & SEED DIVISION

Full 2 1/2 quart sample -- except 10 ear corn. List variety names for all crops. Bring grain in plastic container.

Baled hay - tied 8 inch slice - in a heavy duty plastic bag.

Silage or haylage - bring in 2 1/2 quarts in a plastic container.
